

BUILDING TAROT SKILLS GROUP with ANNE SHOTTER



Learning the theory of Tarot, the traditional meaning of the cards, the psychological correspondences and symbolic stories they suggest is an important first step in using the Tarot for readings. If you have already completed this process, you are probably excited about proceeding to using the cards in Tarot reading.

The symbols of the tarot can also manifest powerful intuitive insights. To become an intuitive practitioner, it is necessary to understand the magical process of a tarot reading and develop the skills of perception and listening.

This is an opportunity to develop reading skills in the context of a small, supportive, supervised setting. Each participant is encouraged to develop their own natural style of working with the Tarot. It also offers an opportunity to share views with others, to see difference, which can expand knowledge already gained.

The course is structured to include:

- Different Tarot spreads** - To encourage a portfolio of useful spreads.
- Each spread will be thoroughly explored.
- Reading on differing subjects** - To develop an understanding of card combinations.
- Timing Systems** - Exploring the use of timing in Tarot readings
- Becoming Professional** - Being professional in your readings for others.

There is also the opportunity for participants to suggest Tarot topics they wish to explore or areas where they feel they have gaps in knowledge or understanding. For ease of reference, the Rider Waite, or a similar deck is the preferred deck for classes. However, other decks are used and insights shared as part of discovering the many different ways in which the energy of a Tarot card is conveyed.

Eligibility: (To join a group you need to have an understanding of the meaning of the 78 Tarot cards at a beginner's level. Feedback from previous groups has shown that participation has been valuable to both experienced users of Tarot as well as those who are commencing their development of reading skills.
